1. Know the rules of the game and teach them to your players. 2. Always abide by the rules of the game. 3. Always treat the umpire with respect, no matter what the call. 4. Exhibit exemplary conduct at both practices and games. The manager/coaches attitude is reflected in team discipline. 5. Coach clean, skillful, honest, and sportsmanlike conduct. 6. You, the manager or coach, are responsible for the conduct of the players at the games. 7. Maintain a climate of enjoyment among the spectators by discouraging negative remarks and/or harassment of umpires, players, parents and spectators. 8. Never use profanity or vulgar language. You are molding the character of your players. 9. Do not allow alcoholic beverages in the vicinity of the playing field. 10. Do not smoke or allow smoking in the area of play or the bench area. 11. Managers and coaches are responsible for the behavior and conduct of their fans to the extent that umpires can request that managers and coaches see that offending fans stop their harassment, and if these fans do not stop this behavior, the managers and coaches can be requested to see that these fans leave the vicinity of ball field, and if these fans refuse this request, the umpire has the power to forfeit the game to the other team.
